

## June 12th, 2022 Minnetonka Tournament Information Sheet

1. Rules Meeting will be held at 6pm on Saturday, June 11th at Shirley Hills Primary School at 2450 Wilshire Blvd, Mound, MN for those who want to attend in person. If you are not comfortable to attend the in person meeting we will be holding it virtually at the same time via Google Meet and Facebook live. It will be recorded on the Student Angler Tournament Trail Presented by Lund & Rapala Facebook page to watch PRIOR to the event as well.
2. We will hold a morning prayer and National Anthem at 6:50am on Sunday morning virtually via Google Meet and Facebook Live at the Student Angler Tournament Trail Presented by Lund & Rapala Facebook page
3. You will need your pin number to enter fish into the app. Pin's will be texted to the angler 1's phone number listed on the registration form the week prior to the event.. Please contact admin@mnsatt.org if you do not have your team's pin and include your school and the anglers names.
4. You can launch your boat at any time but you **may NOT begin fishing until 7am**. Fishing will end at 2pm.
5. **Parking: Our permit is for 225 boats for this event we have to have a parking plan. A Sign up Genius Email will be sent out to select your parking location.**
6. Lake Minnetonka is off limits for fishing as of 5:30pm on Saturday, June 11th, 2022.
7. No kids are allowed to drive or operate the boat when the big motor is running. Except for loading and unloading the boat..
8. Life jackets must be worn while the big motor is running. NO inflatable life jackets for students.
9. No trolling or power fishing from dock to dock.
10. Live bait is NOT permitted in this tournament.
11. Minimum countable length of a smallmouth or largemouth bass is 12". If the tail of the fish touches a line you will round up 1/4". The app will cull your fish for you and count your top 7 fish.
12. If you get an error while using the app please log out and log back in and try again.
13. Fish must be registered on an approved ruler. (Lund, Scheels, Hawg Trough, Ketch Board, Judge or TC Walleye Club)
14. All pictures must be taken in the Time Stamp app and then uploaded into the Reel Livewell app. We must be able to clearly see that the lip of the fish is touching the bump board, mouth is closed, tail is pinched and be able to see the tail of the fish on the ruler in one picture in order for the fish to count.



15. Absolutely no fish in the boat LiveWell at any time. If you catch a fish you are not permitted to fish again until that fish is released.
16. **You will have until 2:30pm to get your photos entered into the Reel Livewell app or contact one of us to report issues prior to 2:30pm or those fish will NOT count.**
17. The awards will be held at Shirley Hills Primary School at 2450 Wilshire Blvd, Mound, MN. **We will send a text message out after the event to let you know what time they will be held at.**
