

How to advance on the SATT Trail

We offer two different ways to advance through the Student Angler Tournament Trail. The first way is to place in the top 10% of each qualifying event to advance to the Tournament of Champions.

For Example for the 2019 year:

Qualifying events are:

- Gull Lake on 6/1/19
- Lake Minnetonka on 6/16/19
- Leech Lake on 6/30/19
- Lake Mille Lacs on 7/14/19
- Lake Le Homme Dieu on 7/28/19
- Mississippi River (Pool 4 only) on 8/11/19

If you finish in the top 10% of registered teams at one of these events you will be invited to the Tournament of Champions on August 25th & 26th on Lake Vermillion.

The second way to advance through the SATT is by earning Team of the Year points. You will be awarded points for each qualifying event that your team fishing based on your placement at the end of the tournament. The points are a 200 point system, so 1st place will receive 200 points, 2nd place will receive 199 points and so on. Your team of the year points will be your combined total points of your top 3 tournament finishes. For every 25 unique boats that fish the SATT we will be able to advance 1 boat to the 2020 National Event being held in Wisconsin.

For example:

If there are 360 unique boats that fish the SATT in 2019, we will be able to advance 14 teams to Nationals in 2020. The spots would be awarded to the highest scoring Team of the Year team going down 14 places, minus any teams that have already advance from another SAF/TBF tournament event.

Team of the year points are award for the **same** 2 person team and can not be combine if you have a different partner for an event.
